- COGGINS TEST: dated w/in 12 months MUST Be presented to show office staff during registration.
- Age of horse as of December 31, 2018
- Age of exhibitor as of January 1, 2018
- Entry/Class ADDS & SCRATCHES with a refund, you MUST do so AT THE SHOW OFFICE at least 3 class prior NO EXCEPTIONS
- Classes will be split at the show committee's discretion.
- All dogs must be on a leash & under control at all times.
