Show information & fees:

- ✓ Office Hours:
 - Friday: 5:15-6pm ONLY for exhibitors entering Friday night classes #1-5**
 - Friday: 6-9 pm for ALL entries
 - Saturday: 7 a.m. through class #57
 - Sunday: 7:30 a.m. through class #82
- ✓ Class Fees:
 - ALL classes are DOUBLE judged (class fee refunded if scratched 3 classes prior)
 - Lead Line/Pee Wee Walk classes= \$8.00 per class
 - Regular (non-jackpot) classes=\$10.00 per class
 - Jackpot classes=\$15.00 per class (payback to top four only, placed thru 6th) no ribbons for this class
- ✓ **WEEKEND BLANKET FEES**-Includes all regular class fees & one (1) stall only.
 - Walk/Trot Blanket Fee-** \$75 per horse/rider w/ 1 stall
 - Walk/Trot/Canter & Green Rider Blanket Fee-** \$120 per horse/rider w/ 1 stall
- ✓ Office Fee: \$1.00 per class entered w/ max. \$12.00 to be charged (no refund on office fee for scratched class(es))
- ✓ Stall/Tack Stall Fee: \$30 per stall/per weekend (no refund once horse and/or bedding is placed in stall)
- ✓ Camping Fee: \$40.00 per space/per weekend-beginning at 2pm Friday, plugged in earlier than 2pm Friday extra \$10.00 (no refunds)
- ✓ Camping w/out electric: \$10 per space/per day
- ✓ Trailer-In Fee (showing from trailer): \$10.00 per horse/per day (no refunds)
- ✓ Membership Information-to earn points towards year end awards, you MUST be a current year member. Your points will not begin accumulating until after you have paid your membership fee. A youth membership (!8 & under as of 1/1/2019) is \$5.00 and an adult membership (19 & over as of 1/1/2019) is \$15.00. You MUST also enter AND show in three (3) of the total five (5) point approved shows AND be in the top 6 in a class(es) to earn a year end award. *Please see the C.M.H.A. rulebook for more information on memberships and year end award qualifications*
- ✓ **ASTM/SEI APPROVED HELMETS ARE REQUIRED IN ALL YOUTH 18 & UNDER ENGLISH/HUNT SEAT CLASSES, LEAD LINE EQ/HORSEMANSHIP & TRAIL CLASSES, PEE WEE EQ/HORSEMANSHIP & TRAIL CLASSES, AND ALL GYMKHANNA EVENTS**
- ✓ **COGGINS TEST:** dated w/in 12 months MUST Be presented to show office staff for every horse on the show grounds
- ✓ Age of horse as of December 31, 2019
- ✓ Age of exhibitor as of January 1, 2019
- ✓ Entry/Class ADDS & SCRATCHES with a refund, you MUST do so AT THE SHOW OFFICE at least 3 class prior NO EXCEPTIONS (class ADDS & SCRATCHES not excepted at the in-gate)
- ✓ Classes will be split at the show committee's discretion
- ✓ All dogs must always be on a leash & under control
- ✓ CMHA and their sponsors are not responsible for losses or accidents on the show grounds
- ✓ Please clean up around your trailer. As a courtesy to others, leave the grounds as clean as when you arrived
- ✓ Stallions to be shown only by exhibitors 19 & older
- ✓ All classes judged by CMHA rules/Judge's decision is final
- ✓ All classes placed to 6th place
- ✓ **FRIDAY EVENING TRAIL CLASSES** are NO BLING optional (MUST wear long pants and boots to match seat ridden, long sleeve shirt, belt if pants have belt loops, and hat/safety helmet to match seat ridden (bathing, banding, fake tails optional)
- ✓ Jackpot classes receive payback through 4th place ONLY
- ✓ **STALL RESERVATIONS:** please email cmhastallres@gmail.com and give the name(s) of the person responsible for payment, # of stalls, and the barn preference. We do our best to get you in the barn/spot of your choice. Your reservation will be confirmed by the Wednesday prior to each show. Please cancel by noon the Thursday before the show to avoid being charged for the stall.
- ✓ Shavings are available to purchase from the fairgrounds \$6.00 per bag pay the fairgrounds directly cash or check payable to S.C.A.S. They will bring them right to your stall.
- ✓ **TRAILER PARKING:** ALL trailers NOT being used for overnight camping MUST BE PARKED in NON-camping areas. DO NOT park trailers in camping, NO HORSES ON THE GRASS or CAMPING AREAS.
